Homework

Homework will be assigned after most classes and will be checked for completion. Homework will count 10% of the nine weeks grade

Late Work

Late homework is not accepted, except in the case of class absence. Other late assignments, such as projects, will be assessed a penalty of 10 points off per school day.

Explanation of Zeroes

A grade of zero will be assigned in the case of missing assignments, zero points earned, or cheating offenses.

Reassessment

Any student who receives a failing grade on a summative assessment may be given an opportunity for additional instruction and will be reassessed through an additional summative assessment, which assesses the deficient objectives. For students who have demonstrated mastery, this test may replace one low test or quiz score of the student's choice.

Make-up Work

Makeup work will be accepted in the case of an excused absence. The student should work with the teacher to arrange times for making up tests and quizzes, usually during study blocks or after school.

Extra Credit

There will occasionally be a bonus problem included on a test or quiz. Any additional extra credit will be the opportunity to work additional problems aligned with unit assessments. These problems are offered after school and are applied to the unit assessment grade. Any bonus or extra credit problems are aligned with the curriculum standards.
