### Homework

Homework will be assigned after most classes and will be checked for completion. Homework will count 10% of the nine weeks grade

### Late Work

Late homework is not accepted, except in the case of class absence. Other late assignments, such as projects, will be assessed a penalty of 10 points off per school day.

### Explanation of Zeroes

A grade of zero will be assigned in the case of missing assignments, zero points earned, or cheating offenses.

### Reassessment

Any student who receives a failing grade on a summative assessment is eligible for reassessment opportunities if the student has no missing assignments and communicates with the teacher about tutoring or extra assistance needed. The highest possible grade on a reassessment is a 64.

### Make-up Work

Makeup work will be accepted in the case of an excused absence. The student should work with the teacher to arrange times for making up tests and quizzes, usually during study blocks or after school. Missed homework assignments should be made up within two blocks of the verified absence or the day of the Unit Test whichever occurs first.

### Extra Credit

No extra credit is offered in this course. There will occasionally be a bonus problem included on a test or quiz.
