Homework

Homework will be assigned after most classes and will be checked for completion. Homework will count 10% of the nine weeks grade

Late Work

Late work (homework, classwork, projects) will be accepted up until the unit test. If not turned by the due date, students may lose up to 50% of the credit.

Explanation of Zeroes

A grade of zero will be assigned in the case of missing assignments, zero points earned, or cheating offenses. If assignments are not completed by the unit test, the zero will remain as the grade for the assignment, but a grade of zero will initially be used as a reminder that the assignment needs to be turned in.

Reassessment

Reassessment can occur if the student has failed the assessment. They must have completed all the assignments for that unit and completed test corrections prior to reassessment. The highest possible grade on a reassessment is a 64.

Make-up Work

Makeup work will be accepted in the case of an absence. The student should work with the teacher to arrange times for making up tests and quizzes, usually during study blocks or after school. Homework is to be completed within two blocks or by the unit test (which ever comes first). Points will not be deducted if the absence is verified.

Extra Credit

No extra credit is offered in Algebra II/Trig. There will occasionally be a bonus problem included on a test or quiz.
