Homework

- In order to be successful in physics, it is crucial that you complete all homework. Homework assignments must be completed since these assignments are essential in reinforcement of the learning of physics.
- You can expect one assignment per week typically.

Late Work

- Late work will be assessed according to the *Course Policies & Procedures of Tidewater Community College of Sciences*
- **Late work will not be accepted without penalty:**
 - **1 day late (24 hours) = 50% of total points can be earned**
 - **Late work will not be accepted after 1 day.**
- Extenuating circumstances impacting submission of work must be brought to the attention of the instructor PRIOR to the assignment's due date.

Explanation of Zeroes

- When you do not turn in an assignment, it will be marked "Missing" in the grade book. If you were absent, the assignment will be marked "Absent." Work marked "absent" will be treated as make up work.
- A "zero" will be entered as a placeholder until it is completed. A "zero" will be locked into the gradebook at the end of the eighth week of the nine weeks period in accordance with the late work policy.

Reassessment

- Any student receiving a grade of 63 or lower on a summative assessment may complete a retake after satisfactorily completing a remediation assignment.

Make-up Work
