



## Grading Practices

### Homework

Homework will be assigned daily and may consist of a continuation of class work, cover new material, or will review the content of the current unit. Homework will count for 10% of a student's overall grade.

### Late Work

Students who are present in class are expected to turn in assignments by the given due date. If the assignment is not turned in by the due date, the student may submit the assignment for a reduced grade. All latework must be turned in by the unit test.

### Explanation of Zeroes

Zeros may be place holders for missing assessments to serve as a reminder to complete the assessment. Once the assessments are made up, the earned grade will replace the zero in the gradebook. If the student does not make up the missing assessments by the time they take the unit test, the zero will remain in the gradebook.

### Reassessment

Reassessment opportunities may be available on any summative assessment for any student who:

1. Has no missing assignments
2. Communicates with the teacher about tutoring or extra assistance needed

Students' scores for unit assessments may replace quiz scores in the same unit if the test score is higher than the quiz score(s).

### Make-up Work

All students are provided the opportunity to make up any missed assignments due to class absences as long as the missed assignments are completed and turned in before the student takes the unit test. If the student is able to demonstrate mastery of the content, they may not need to complete all missing work; this is a conversation to take place between the teacher and student.

### Extra Credit

Extra credit may be presented as bonus questions on class assessments and will be related to the current content or a review of previous material covered. If additional extra credit assignments become available, they will only be offered to students with no missing assignments.
