Homework

Homework will be assigned after most classes and will be checked for completion. Homework will count 10% of the nine weeks grade

Late Work

Late homework is not accepted, except in the case of class absence. Other late assignments, such as projects, will be assessed a penalty of 10 points off per school day.

Explanation of Zeroes

A grade of zero will be assigned and entered in the grade portal in the case of missing homework assignments, A grade of zero will be assigned if zero points are earned or for cheating offenses on class assignments, tests, quizzes, or projects; for missing assignments MI will be entered and will be calculated as a zero. Any grade of zero, not MI, may not be made up.

Reassessment

Any student who receives a failing grade on a summative assessment may be given an opportunity for additional instruction and will be reassessed through an additional summative assessment, which assesses the deficient objectives. For students who have demonstrated mastery, this test may replace one low test or quiz score of the student's choice.

Make-up Work

Makeup work will be accepted in the case of an excused absence. The student should work with the teacher to arrange times for making up tests and quizzes, usually during study blocks or after school; arrangements must be made within 3 days of returning from an absence. Homework and other class assignments must be made up within 3 days of returning to school.

Extra Credit

No extra credit is offered in this course. There will occasionally be a bonus problem included on a test or quiz. Bonus questions will be aligned to current curriculum standards.
