Homework

Homework is usually part of other work: classwork, projects, etc. Homework becomes an extension of class time. There will not be a separate homework grade

Late Work

Late work will be assessed with a MAXIMUM 20% deduction. Late work will be accepted with a penalty up to a week before the marking period is over. Late work is any work not turned in on the due date (preassigned work) or not turned in within the week after an excused absence. Work not turned in by the designated quarter deadline will receive no credit.

For projects that are time sensitive, students may be given the opportunity to complete, depending on the circumstances.

Projects that are directly related to a real-life production will not be accepted late and cannot be made up.

Explanation of Zeroes

If a student never completes an assignment, then a grade of 20% will be assigned. Students caught cheating will receive a zero on the assignment.

Reassessment

Students may rework and re-submit an assignment and retake a quiz/test for points added to grade. The two grades will be averaged for a new grade.

Make-up Work

Students have responsibility of obtaining notes, assignments, etc. when absent. Preassigned assignments that can be turned in digitally will still be due on the due date regardless of absence. Make-up work for extenuating circumstances will be determined by the instructor. Work that cannot be turned in digitally, such as presentations, must be made up within a week of the assigned due date, otherwise it will be classified as late work. Projects that are directly related to a real-life production will not be accepted late and cannot be made up.
