### Homework

### Late Work

### Reassessment

**Students will be given the opportunity to reassess provided that the student has participated in class, completed assignments, and demonstrated evidence of best effort on the assessment and the learning leading up to the assessment**

**All assignments may be made up (whether excused or unexcused) and work is due by the end of the unit (before that individual student takes or makes up the unit test). No penalty for make up work.**

**Students may be given an opportunity for extra credit each marking period. Extra credit will be added as a component of a summative assessments**
