### Late Work

### Explanation of Zeroes

**zeros will act as a place holder for any missing assignment for excused and unexcused absences. Grades will be updated upon completion and reception of the missing assignment. If the assignment is not made up by the imposed deadline for each grading quarter, the zero will remain.**

### Reassessment

**Students have the opportunity to do test corrections on all summative assessments. Each corrected answer is worth half the original credit (for example if a question is worth 2 points they may receive 1 for a corrected answer). Test corrections are available to any student no matter the score provided they have completed all unit assignments leading up to the assessment.**

### Make-up Work

**All assignments may be made up (whether excused or unexcused) and work is due by the end of the unit lessons (before unit test). No penalty for make up work**

### Extra Credit

**All students have an opportunity for extra credit as it applies to the subject objectives.**
