Homework

If homework is assigned, it will be checked for completion and will not exceed 10% of the 9 weeks grade

Late Work

Late work will be assessed with a MAXIMUM 50% deduction. Late work is any work not turned in on the due date (including classwork) or not turned in within the week after an excused absence. Work not turned in by the designated quarter deadline (progress reports and report cards) will receive no credit.

Explanation of Zeroes

A code and/or comment will be used to indicate missing work, absences, or late work. This code indicates an assignment was not done and either needs to be made up for full, or in some cases, partial credit. If the assignment is not made up by the designated quarter deadline (progress reports and report cards), a zero shall be assigned.

Reassessment

Reassessments are for students who have not mastered the content/learning targets. Students are responsible to contact the teacher to set up a reassessment opportunity before the designated quarter deadline (progress reports and report cards).

Make-up Work

Students are responsible to communicate with their teacher regarding make-up work in a timely manner and schedule an appointment to make up any missing assessments. Make-up work will receive full credit. Students will be required to complete all make-up work within 7 days of returning to school or it will be classified as late work. The deadline can be extended at the teacher's discretion to accommodate



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special circumstances. Students are responsible for informing the teacher if they need additional time to complete make-up work.
